



# Packing List

## RIDING GEAR

- Riding Hat** - we require all riders on our holidays to wear a riding hat. Protective headwear must meet one of the following standards:  
  
British – All PAS 015, VG1 - provided they are BSI Kitemarked  
European – VG1 - provided they are BSI Kitemarked  
American – SEI ASTM F1163 04a onwards and SNELL E2001  
Australian & New Zealand – AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.
- Gloves** - you may wish to choose light coloured, lightweight gloves suitable for hot weather riding to ensure your hands don't over heat .
- Riding Top** - again avoid dark colours and we suggest you go for a breathable top with long sleeves made of cotton.
- Jodphurs**  
Riding boots - Jodphur boots are best but whichever you prefer.
- Half chaps** - If required.
- Underwear** - We at HTH love the seamless underwear from Derriere Equestrian.
- Socks** - Breathable & odour eating are best.
- Back protector** - If required  
  
No riding crops/spurs please.

## NON-RIDING

- Change of clothes** – Anything comfy that you can wear in the evenings to dinner or when sightseeing on rest days: Flip Flops / trainers, trousers / shorts, T-shirts, Jumper,
- Sunnies**
- Wide Brimmed hat**
  
- Book** - (long lunch breaks)
- Torch**
- Wash bag** - don't forget SPF lip balm
- Suncream**
- Mosquito repellent** (at least 50% DEET is best)  
Small first aid kit
  
- Electronics** – Camera, Mobile, Go Pro or similar.
- Chargers.**
- Adapters.** The sockets in India take type D plugs (large round prongs).

## TOP TIPS

- Break In your boots** - If you have bought new boots for the holiday don't forget to wear them around the house first to break them in ready for the ride.
  
- Bank cards** - Don't forget if you need to notify your bank that you will be travelling abroad so they don't block your card should you want to use it abroad. A load of extra hassle that can easily be avoided.
  
- Pack light** - Although we do provide a support vehicle to carry your luggage you don't want to bring a massive suitcase that needs lugging from place to place.

## DON'T FORGET...

- Passport**
- Indian Visa** - Please note that you will need a visa to enter India. These are not possible to get upon arrival so please already have one before landing in India!
- Cash** - you may wish to bring some cash with you to exchange into rupees upon arrival. Please note that you cannot get rupees outside of India.
- Insurance Documents** - please print off a copy of your insurance documents to keep on your person whilst riding.
